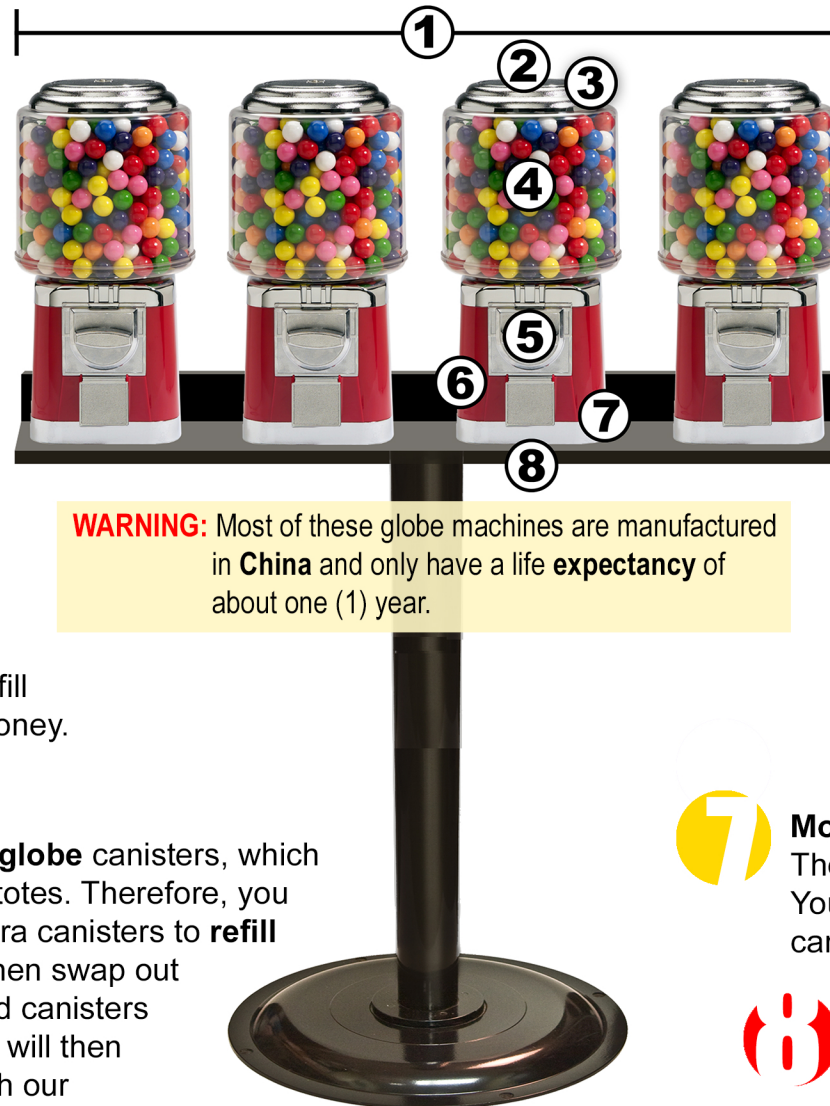


Do You Know What Is **Wrong** With This Style Vending Machine Called **The Globe Machine**?



1 **Machine too large to place easily**
This style machine is designed **horizontally!** It requires too much floor space and won't fit into a corner of a room making it difficult to place.

2 **Cheap Locks**
The locks are a cheap, **flat-key** style, which are very easy to **pick** or **break** open!

3 **Servicing Nightmare!**
You must remove four (4) locks and four (4) lids to fill with candy or remove the money.

4 **Servicing Nightmare!**
This style design machine has **globe** canisters, which do **not** fit into any size service totes. Therefore, you will not be able to purchase extra canisters to **refill** them back at your **home** and then swap out the empty canisters for the filled canisters at the stores. Your service time will then be **double** what it would be with our 4-in-1 vending machines.

5 **Cheap Coin Mechanism**
Accepts Slugs and Jams
Coin mechanisms are constructed of **cheap**, scrap metal, like aluminum, only made to work for about one (1) year and then need **replacing!** Most of these 25¢ coin mechanisms cannot be swapped out for 50¢ coin mechanisms.

6 **Cheaply Constructed Case**
The **case** that holds the money is either constructed of **cheap** plastic or **cheap** scrap metal, like aluminum. They are both very easy to **crack**, **dent**, or **break** into the case and **steal** your money!

7 **Money is Difficult to Remove**
The money is very difficult to **remove!** You must **remove** the entire globe canister. There is no side access.

8 **No Spill Trays**
A **must have** feature to keep snacks from spilling onto the floor.
